Parsons Memorial Library Code of Conduct

The Parsons Memorial Library seeks to provide a safe, secure, and welcoming environment for all members of the community and the library staff. The Parsons Memorial Library Board of Trustees has approved the following guidelines to maintain a safe and enjoyable atmosphere.

Library users may not engage in behavior that disrupts the comfortable and safe use of the library by others, hinder the operations of the library and/or monopolizes the time of the staff.

Such behaviors include but are not limited to:

- Engage in any illegal activity
- Smoke any substance, use tobacco, e-cigarettes, alcohol, or illegal substances on library property.
- Be in the library without shoes or shirt.
- Create public disturbances.
- Use obscene and/or abusive language or gestures.
- Engage in harassment or threatening behavior.
- Engage in cell phone or video use that disrupts other users of the library.
- Mutilate, damage, or deface any library materials, furniture, or equipment.
- Solicit and/or petition on library property.
- Children under the age of 8 left unattended.

Persons who ignore staff requests to comply with these guidelines may be asked to leave the property. Persons who repeatedly violate this policy or pose a threat to the comfort and safety of others may have their library privileges restricted or suspended.
