Same premise: borrow a book without knowing its title; read the 'one-liners' on the book wrappers; choose one and take a chance!

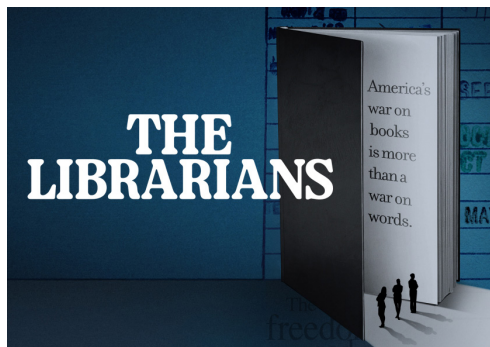
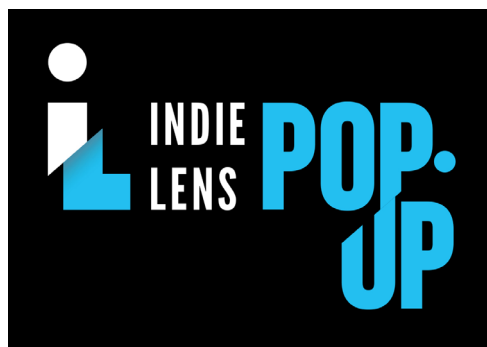
