



Alfred Conservation Commission

A Shrine Trail • Shaker Hill Road • distance: 1 mile
 Trail head starts by the Shaker cemetery & continues by shrines & through the woods, passing “Mt. Notre Dame” & looping back across a recreation field to Shaker Hill Road. Terrain is easy with some uneven surfaces.

B Shaker Woods Reserve • Stone Road • distance: 2.5 miles
 Trail head starts at parking lot and continues through the woods leading to a loop with multiple water views. Follow signs around loop. Terrain is easy with some uneven surfaces.

C Massabesic Experimental Forest Ida Jim & Whicher’s Mill Roads
 distances:
 BC Jordan trail .3 mile
 Littlefield trail .8 mile
 Clayton Carl trail .4 mile
 Atlantic White Cedar loop .7 mile
 Charles E. Swett trail .5 mile

Multiple trails within 1500+ acres of US Forest Service land. Terrain varies by trail, but they’re all easy with some uneven surfaces. ** Please note: the dirt road between gates on Ida Jim Road is clear, but all side trails have downed trees from the April 2024 ice storm. They are passable by foot, but with many obstacles.
